How to Dispose of **Oversized Waste?**

Oversized waste refers to waste that cannot be wrapped in designated bags!



Confirm with the property management the oversized waste collection arrangements

(If there is no property management service, the FEHD's waste collection services would generally be used)

Employ FEHD's waste collection services Hire private waste collection services

(refuse collection vehicles without rear compactors)

Buy designated labels from authorised retail outlets



Affix a designated label to each oversized waste



Gate-fee could be shared by households according to the methods below:

Specify the fee levels for common oversized waste*

Property management companies may charge additional administrative/transportation fees
