

How to Handle and Dispose of Waste?

Recycle more,
dump less, save more!



Work with owners' corporations/property management companies/residents' organisations
Determine the waste collection mode and ways to handle non-compliant waste (NCW)

Charging by Designated Bags / Labels



Before handing over to the refuse collection vehicles, **ensure all waste is properly wrapped in designated bags or affixed oversized waste with designated labels**



Report the usage of designated bags, the amount and location of NCW, and report serious non-compliant cases



Charging by Weight



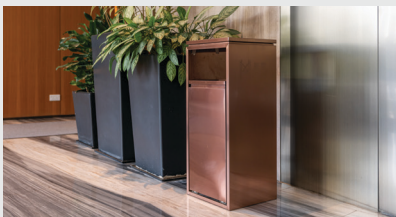
Use ordinary garbage bags to collect waste as usual



Check waste handling at different disposal locations

Common Areas

Small litter containers
not required to line designated bags



Wrap all the collected waste in designated bags or affix with designated labels

Communal Waste Reception Areas

Check for NCW
(Use transparent bags to wrap the designated bags if necessary)



Use designated bags / labels to handle NCW

Reject any NCW disposed of in person
