

How to Handle the Waste Disposed by the Public at Refuse Collection Points?

Recycle more,
dump less, save more!



Check and confirm whether the waste complies with the law

✓ Compliant Waste



The opening of the bag must be completely tied



Affixed with a designated label on each piece of oversized waste

✗ Non-compliant Waste (NCW)



Some of the waste protrudes from / pierces through the body of the bag



The opening of the bag is not tied well



No designated labels affixed on the oversized waste

If NCW is found, the frontline cleansing workers should refuse to accept the waste

If necessary, relevant requirements should be explained to the public, i.e. wrapping the waste in designated bags or affixing oversized waste with designated labels

Frontline cleansing workers should report to the supervisor on duty and seek help if members of the public disregard the advice and deposit NCW at refuse collection points
